



CAMP KINNEYWOOD SWIM POLICY

Camp Kinneywood requires structured swimming lessons as an integral component of participating in our summer camp. Lessons are designed to offer new swimmers basic skills as well as water safety skills and education. ***Campers are required to take swim lessons in order to participate in free swim.***

If your child is to be excused from swimming for the day we require that you provide us with a note. If your child is to be excused for an extended period of time then a note from the child's physician is required. If your child is not swimming, they must sit at the waterfront during lessons to observe so that they do not fall behind.

On the first day of camp your child's swimming skills will be assessed by our waterfront staff. Your child will be placed in lanes according to their ability and skill levels. Your child may be placed in a lane lower than they normally swim in due to the fact that there is no pool side to hang on to, they will be swimming in open water.

If your child does not feel comfortable with swimming lessons, then they might do better in our Girls Inc In-Town Summer Fun program at Winthrop House.
